Prez Sez'

Last week we heard from Tom Reesor who shared with us some stories about immigration law and the current situation with illegal immigrants in the local workforce. Tom, who currently works as a Labor Consultant for the TN Wage and Hour Division, has extensive experience with the immigration enforcement and those persons who set out to break our laws. He regaled us with several stories which, while humorous, serve to illustrate the state of the situation as far as the penetration of the workforce in Middle America by illegals.

One story revolved around a raid at the Monterey Mushroom plant in Loudon County. The "raid" netted 273 illegal workers from a 300 person workforce. The illegals were loaded onto busses and taken to Brownsville TX, where they were turned over to the border patrol for deportation to Mexico.

As they drove the busses back to TN, after taking time out for a shower, shave and a hot meal, Tom and the other "drivers" were soon shocked. Just a few miles East of Brownsville, they were passed by a small honking car and whose occupants waived enthusiastically at the bus driver. They were his charges on the road to deportation only hours earlier. They, in fact, beat him home to Tennessee.
