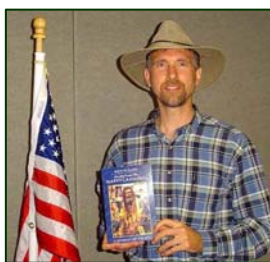

Ron told us not only about the physical aspects of his travels but also the emotional, cultural, and spiritual aspects that lead him to gain insight into the root cause of poverty, the influence of culture on individuals value systems and world view.

Ron's travels started in 1991 while on a ski trip where he encountered poor snow conditions which lead him to spend his time traveling around Europe. This sparked the travel bug & lead to the 1st trip: Great Britain and Scandinavia, Russia, Usbgekistan, Ukraine & Eastern Europe. His 2nd trip took him to Turkey, Israel, Egypt, and Ukraine, again. The 3rd trip: Thailand, Nepal, Indonesia, Singapore. And finally: Hong Kong, China, Japan, Australia, and New Zeland. Couple these trips with forays across most of North & South America, Southern & Eastern Africa and you will see that there aren't many places Ron hasn't been.

Ron's travels and his questioning mind have led him to conclude that we, as Americans, are uniquely blessed by a culture that tollerates indivuality, values individual effort and success, and presupposes protection for those who cannot protect themselves.
