Prez Sez'

Another great program last week as Roy & Suzie Ferguson spoke to us about the Tennessee Special Response Team-A, Inc. (rescue dogs). Roy spoke but the real celebrities were Cherokee & Schatzie, two German shepards who form the K-9 half of this team.



TN SRT-A search dogs are experts in tracking/trailing, air scenting and human remains detection on land *and* water. They provide adjunct services to law enforcement, missing person search & rescue, drownings, natural disasters, accidents and/or foul play.

The program is demanding and requires dedication. Roy and Suzie train 2 days a week with the dogs: providing for all the dogs' needs. To top it off, they don't charge for their services; not the public nor to the families they help.

Searching for a missing person requires 176 trained searchers walking 30 feet apart 3.5 hours, to search 1 sq. mile (85% chance of locating the lost person). This is 616 hours with an average cost of \$7,000.

The same area can be covered by one Tennessee Special Response Team-A Search/Rescue trained K-9 & handler in about 3 hours, costing \$zero. And their success rate is higher! TN SRT-A Team members volunteer their services for rescue missions, public education programs & extensive training sessions. *Roy and Suzie: our hats are off to you.* For more information, go to: www.tnsrta.org

P.S. By way, the club raised \$450 to send to TN SRT-A, helping offset their costs. Great job, Club!
