Last Week, our own Leslie Frederick brought us up-to-date about dynamic Kiwanis programs targeting participation by our youngsters. These programs have dual purposes: to providing leadership training & a chance for our youth to work together in community outreach, and are excellent training grounds for the Kiwanians of tomorrow.

Leslie talked about the  program we will be starting at Rocky Hill Elementary. The administration at Rocky Hill was looking for a program to teach leadership skills and were so impressed with the


success of our  program that they jumped at the possibility of establishing a K-Kids, too. **K-Kids** provides the platform for children to choose leaders, participate in organized club meetings, select community projects, raise funds & achieve group goals.

She also spoke about  **Builders Clubs** which are targeted to Middle Schoolers and with K-Kids. Although our Club does not sponsor a Builders Club, other clubs in Division 5 do.

Builders Club provides a way to form sound personal values based on experiences in meaningful community-service activities. The members learn by doing. They learn organization, teamwork, and leadership. The most important thing they can learn is that working together we can, and do, make a difference in the world around us.

Key Clubs are High School equivalent to Kiwanis. They continue the theme of developing strong, caring community members and outstanding leaders. Fred Berry shared some of **South Doyle Key Club** activities: Roadside clean-up projects; a car wash fund raiser which brought in \$700; participation with Second Harvest Food Bank & Trick or Treat for UNICEF. They also hold "5th quarter" activities for students after home football games.

These young people's clubs are a vital link in the Kiwanis chain. They are a wonderful training ground for future Kiwanians plus they provide services for young people which they can get in very few places in today's society: Leadership training and the opportunity for altruistic service. They need our help and support. Its amazing the impact of a

single interested adult on the outlook of a child.
